Under ORC 2945.71:

- A. A person against whom a charge of minor misdemeanor is pending in a court of record shall be brought to trial within 30 days after his arrest or the service of summons.
- B. A person against whom a charge of misdemeanor, other than a minor misdemeanor, is pending in a court of record shall be brought to trial:
  - 1. Within forty-five days after his/her arrest or the service of summons, if the offense charge is a misdemeanor, for which the maximum penalty is imprisonment for not more than sixty days;
  - 2. Within ninety days after his/her arrest or the service of summons, if the offense charges is a misdemeanor of the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, or other misdemeanor for which the maximum penalty is imprisonment for more than sixty days.
- C. A person against whom a charge of felony is pending:
  - 1. Shall be accorded a preliminary hearing within fifteen days after his arrest.
  - 2. If incarcerated, within 10 days after his arrest.

With full knowledge of the Code provision, I hereby waive my right to speedy trial in the above case.
